FY 2016 Goals and Objectives

GOAL I

Promote community awareness, education and support for a system of integrated services for individuals with a behavioral health disorder.

- **Objective 1.1:** Monitor legislation that affects behavioral health funding and services and maintain a quick response system to share information.
 - **Action Step 1.1.1:** HCMHA will educate local community, elected officials, providers, consumers and family members on issues related to services and funding.
 - **Action Step 1.1.2:** HCMHA will provide materials on health and wellness at various Health Fairs and to community organizations upon request.
- **Objective 1.2:** Promote a system of integrated care that focuses on improved health and wellness for populations served.
 - **Action Step 1.2.1:** HCMHA will encourage providers to address treatment issues related to co-occurring substance use and mental health issues.
 - **Action Step 1.2.2:** HCMHA will review the outcomes in WayStation's Health Home pilot project that co-locates somatic healthcare with outpatient treatment services.
 - **Action Step 1.2.3:** HCMHA will work with providers to monitor the somatic health status of individuals residing in state funded residential services.
 - **Action Step 1.2.4:** HCMHA will monitor programs developed by On Our Own of Howard County (OOOHC) at the Wellness and Recovery Center that promote health and wellness.
- **Objective 1.3:** Establish a coordinated prevention effort on behavioral health in partnership with the Health Department Bureau of Substance Abuse Services.
 - **Action Step 1.3.1:** Collaborate with existing community resources to develop and implement a prevention program that is effective across the lifespan.
 - **Action Step 1.3.2:** Research available funding sources willing to fund prevention efforts.
 - **Action Step 1.3.3:** Promote prevention strategies through health fairs and publicly recognized events such a "Recovery Month", Mental Health Awareness Week, Mental Health Month.
 - **Action Step 1.3.4:** Implement an Opioid Overdose Prevention Plan in partnership with the Health Department Bureau of Substance Abuse Services.

GOAL II

Services are focused on the Recovery Model and are culturally competent as well as consumer and family driven:

- **Objective 2.1:** HCMHA will promote "Recovery" in all its forms throughout the local system through partnerships.
 - **Action Step 2.1.1:** HCMHA will operate a Foreign-Born Outreach Project to address the treatment needs of populations in various languages.
 - **Action Step 2.1.2:** HCMHA will assure that information is available in different languages as needed for dissemination to the community.
 - **Action Step 2.1.3:** HCMHA will research issues related to sexual identity as it relates to behavioral health services and share this information with the provider community.
 - **Action Step 2.1.4:** HCMHA will work closely with established cultural communities in its jurisdiction to effectively address behavioral health needs.

GOAL III

Utilize all available data to analyze trends, improve the quality of services and maintain system accountability.

- **Objective 3.1:** HCMHA staff and Board members will monitor existing data to determine trends in service utilization.
 - **Action Step 3.1.1:** The Health Care Policy & Planning Committee of the Board will review available data at the end of each quarter.
- **Objective 3.2:** HCMHA will request available data from the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Administration (ADAA) regarding co-occurring issues.
 - **Action Step 3.2.1:** HCMHA will attempt to identify individuals who are receiving services in both the mental health and substance abuse systems using available data resources.
- Objective 3.3: Identify existing funds to hire data analysis consultant as needed.

 Action Step 3.3.1: HCMHA will expand available staffing to include a data analysis consultant to routinely assist staff and Board in analyzing data trends.

GOAL IV

Develop and maintain partnerships across community agencies, the provider community and general public that will promote an efficient delivery of behavioral health services.

- **Objective 4.1:** Maintain existing partnerships and participation on Boards and committees throughout the county.
 - **Action Step 4.1.1:** HCMHA will maintain accurate list of Boards and committees on which staff participate.
 - **Action Step 4.1.2:** HCMHA will maintain minutes from 4.1.1. above in a binder that is accessible to all staff and Board members.
- **Objective 4.2:** Develop new partnerships as needed to address mental health/behavioral health issues.
 - **Action Step 4.2.1:** Review available grant funding opportunities that may result in new partnerships to address mental health/behavioral health issues.
 - **Action Step 4.2.2:** HCMHA staff will participate on any new committees or task forces developed locally.

GOAL V

Collaborate with the local Health Department and county government to integrate both the administrative functions and services of a local Behavioral Health entity.

- **Objective 5.1:** Continue regular meetings with leadership of the Health Department to address the integration of the administrative functions of a local behavioral health entity.
 - Action Step 5.1.1: HCMHA will attend the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Advisory Board (ADAAB) and the Health Department's Bureau of Behavioral Health will attend HCMHA's Board meeting.
- **Objective 5.2:** HCMHA will continue to coordinate with the Health Department Bureau of Behavioral Health to jointly fund a Wellness and Recovery Center operated by On Our Own of Howard County.
 - **Action Step 5.2.1:** HCMHA will meet regularly with Health Department's Bureau of Behavioral Health staff and On Our Own of Howard County to assure Conditions of Award for both grants are being met.
